SECTION 4: EXHAUST EMISSIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

Aircraft exhaust emissions regulations are imposed on engine manufacturers and aircraft will not be issued a Certificate of Airworthiness, or equivalent, unless the engines are approved by the state of registry. ICAO Annex 16 Volume II describes emissions regulations applicable to civil aircraft.

2. EMISSIONS CHARGES

As of the date of this manual, operators of business aircraft in the United States are not subject to an Emissions Trading Scheme and the Company is therefore exempt from the ETS in effect in the European Union.
